

Extended power down advisory

Overview

Because of recent government restrictions on the operation of gaming venues, this notice provides guidance to operators and technicians who maintain Aristocrat EGMs that will ensure they remain in full operational condition after an extended shutdown. This notice applies to all Aristocrat EGMs.

Aristocrat EGMs are equipped with non-volatile data storage with a battery backup. These batteries are high capacity and non-rechargeable. No charging is required and battery drain is prevented while the EGM is turned ON. An EGM can be turned OFF for several years and still provide sufficient battery power to preserve any data stored in the non-volatile memory.

If the preservation of this data is not a concern, an EGM may remain turned OFF indefinitely.

If the preservation of this data is mandatory, turn the EGM ON every three months and inspect the condition of the batteries on the logic board. If a **battery low** condition is present, replace the batteries. See the following table for guidance.

If it is discovered that data is lost upon turning an EGM ON, replace the batteries and follow the recommended setup procedure to configure the EGM and the game.
